Q. What are the differences between the Hikari FLETS Fiber Optic services?

A. NTT East and NTT West both provide a variety of different Hikari Flets (Fiber Optic) services. Here is a breakdown of what each service offers and the differences between them

Please note, the information below refers to both the Family type and Mansion type Hikari FLETS services from NTT. Please refer to the FAQ page [here](#) for a description of the difference between Family and Mansion type services.

| Service Type | Bandwidth | NTT Cost | FUSION GOL Cost | Details |

| BFLETS | Up to 100Mbps | NTT charges depend on the type of service installed and any campaigns you are subscribed to *1 | 1,869yen per month (inc. tax) | This is the older fiber optic service that is no longer provided by NTT for new applicants and has been replaced by the FLETS Hikari Hext service |
| FLETS Hikari Next | Up to 100Mbps | | | This is the improved fiber optic service from NTT that has replaced the BFLETS service and should provide more stable connections and bandwidth |
| FLETS Hikari Next High Speed Type | Up to 200Mbps | | | Where available, NTT will provide the High Speed Type service as it provides higher bandwidth when compared to the BFLETS and FLETS Hikari Next services |
| FLETS Hikari Light (NTT East only) | Up to 100Mbps | Monthly charge depends on data usage *2 | | Recommended to users who are not using internet services on a regular basis. The charges from NTT vary depending on usage for both Family and Mansion plans. If more than 1GB of data is expected to be used within a month, we recommend using one of the regular FLETS Hikari Next services |
| FLETS Hikari Premium (NTT West only) | Up to 100Mbps | NTT charges depend on the type of service installed and any campaigns you are subscribed to *1 | | The Hikari Premium service provided to customers in the NTT West area comes with both an ONU (fiber optic modem) and a CTU (IPv6 bridge). The CTU device can act either as a router or as a bridge if you would like to connect your own router to it. However, the CTU must always be connected to the ONU in order to use the connection when using the Premium type fiber optic service |
| FLETS Super High Speed/Hayabusa Type (NTT West only) | Up to 1Gbps | | | This service is similar to the FLETS Hikari Next service offered in NTT West areas but provides greater bandwidth |
